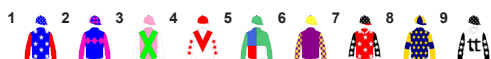

Splash Of Colour ran sixth on debut behind Una The Unicorn, Jockey Gavin Lerena has been booked to ride this filly from a good draw, she should improve nicely from her first start.
