





Race Preview: Blue Holly (5) is back over what looks to be her preferred trip. This is her third run in KZN and should be at her peak. Mia's Athena (3) has had her problems but has her third run back after a lengthy break. She was close-up last start has a light weight. She can give apprentice Savanna Valjalo her first winner. Convocation (4) was possibly out-classed in the SA Fillies Sprint last time out after showing good form to weaker prior to that. She may prefer it a touch further. Vision To Achieve (6) has been in mustard form over course and distance. She has a handy weight and can go in again.



Race Preview: Future Swing (8) was a close-up second to the lightly weighted Field Marshal (5) last time out. He is 5.5kg better off at the weights so should be able to turn the tables. Holding Thumbs (6) is 2.5kg better off with Future Swing on their Field Marshall encounter. He stays the distance well and looks the part. Cape Eagle (2) goes well over course and distance and had no luck in running in the WSB 1900. He is seldom out of the money. Field Marshal looks well held at the weights but is an improving three-year-old and can still give a lot of cheek.
