She has not been out since May but looks more than capable in this lineup and looks a big threat to the selection. Queen Fenn is seldom far back and Callan Murray stays with the ride. Chericherilady ran a fair race first up for her new stable. She gets a 4kg claimer aboard and can make the required improvement.
