Race Preview: Prized Platinum bounced back from a disappointing KZN display with an impressive last-start win at this level when stretching out to 1400m for the first time. He copped the maximum 8-point penalty for that runaway victory but could follow up, even under top weight, if confirming that improvement over the extended trip. Class-droppers Fostinovo and Prince Of Kildare have the means to pose a threat in this grade, along with improving recent maiden scorer Matroosberg who should make his presence felt. With the aid of rider's 4kg allowance, consistent Peregrine Falcon should trouble the selection.

Recent maiden scorers Miami Mountain and Romilly face a test of their mettle against opposition of this quality but they also have scope for progress so will likely hold their own from favourable inside stalls. The form of the latter's debut win has been franked so it could be worth siding with him.
