Race Preview: Spaarne Rivier was a comfortable maiden winner on the poly at second time of asking and enjoyed the step up in trip. This distance should suit and he can follow up. Banzai Pipeline is slowly coming down in the ratings and was not far back when taking on stronger last time out. He has a handy galloping weight with a 4kg claimer aboard and the best of the draw. Ultra Quick has been in good form over shorter and could now prefer this step up in distance. Pembury ran way below what he is capable of in his first try out of the maidens but he did have a difficult draw. He can do better here.
