Race Preview: Hierarchy has a tough draw as she takes on males but ran a cracker behind stable companion Asiye Phambili in the Grade 1 SA Fillies Sprint at WFA. She has a big weight but with some luck in running she may be the one to beat. **Chapbook** has come well since the blinkers have been restored and was narrowly beaten by the smart Taxi To The Moon last run although getting lumps of weight. He meets weaker in what is an open affair. **African Pride** has won over course and distance and has the best of the draw but there should not be much between him and **Chapbook** given their last meeting. **Circumbendibus** has hardly been out of the money since arriving in KwaZulu-Natal and will be a factor again.
